 - 2nd Family Member over 18 is \$270 plus \$100 volunteer hour buyout; (Must already know how to row)
 - 3rd Family Member over 18 is \$225 plus \$100 volunteer hour buyout; (Must already know how to row)
- Adult Open Classification, age 21-25: \$300/year (Must already know how to row and includes 10 volunteer hours)
- Collegiate Rower (18-23 yrs.): \$120 June, July and August and is not prorated for late arrival/early departure.
- RCTW Alumni Youth Rower (18-23yrs.): FREE
- Out of area membership (Must already know how to row), ½ year or less: \$275
- Guest Rowers from other clubs: Donation (tax deductible)
- Guest rower of RCTW Member, (experienced only): First three visits are FREE
